PANTHEON IMPLEMENTATION PROJECT MANAGEMENT - Part 2 (PM Competence II)

Objectives

Designing the ongoing management of projects effectively in terms of quality and climate while remaining efficient and using as few resources as possible is critical to the success of projects and is also the key challenge that project managers must master.

In this training, the participants will learn how they can actively design PANTHEON IMPLEMENTION project management processes in the team (including customers and suppliers) to ensure that they can react flexibly to changes. They will especially learn how to implement a common viewpoint and effective project structures during the project start, cyclical and integrated project monitoring and controlling process, and will be able to ensure long-term knowledge transfer for future projects. Together they will discuss critical success factors on concrete PANTHEON examples and will expand on what they learn by completing an example project.

- Processes of project and process oriented organisation, project initiation
 Training objective: PANTHEON implementation project main processes, milestones, documents. Connection between sales process (initation) and PANTHEON implementation project management
- Project start: process design, means of communication, team building Training objective: Reach the understanding why start process is crucial for the successful implementation. What is the role of the project management and the core team? How to integrate the customer and external suppliers? How to set up the organisation and communication? How to organise the start workshop and kick off meeting... Presentation of the lessons learned from selected pilot project. Use of PANTHEON specific process, milestones and documents (templates).
- Project monitoring and controlling: cyclical controlling of the hard and soft facts Training objective: What is project monitoring and controlling? How to conduct a controlling meeting with the core project team (use of the case study)? Reporting to the Project sponsor and to the customer... Use of PANTHEON specific process, milestones and documents (templates).
- Continuous project marketing and project coordination tasks
 Training objective: How to manage stakeholder relationships and expectations during the entire project? How to setup the optimum communication with all relevant stakeholders? Difference between project management and project coordination? Use of PANTHEON specific documents (templates).
- Project closing: evaluation of the project deliverables, dissolution of the project team, organisational learning
 - Training objective: How to organise the project close down workshop (analyse the project results, conduct lessons learned, feedback and customer satisfaction) and transfer the results back to organisation (continuous improvement)? Use of PANTHEON specific process and documents (templates).
